CJ Tirone serves as an Executive Vice President of the Home Builders Institute (HBI) and is responsible for approximately 69 HBI Job Corps centers and their 144 residential construction training programs that serve more than 3,000 youth per year.

Tirone oversees an HBI Job Corps program with a \$17 million budget and a staff of 170. He has served on workgroups for the National Office of Job Corps, part of the U.S. Department of Labor's Employment and Training Administration and works closely with personnel in the Department's Office of Apprenticeship.

As a senior leader with HBI, Tirone serves as a liaison with construction industry, government, for-profit and non-profit officials at all levels. Tirone joined HBI in 1978 and has worked in a variety of roles including a career technical instructor, placement coordinator, and program manager. As a former home improvement contractor, Tirone was a subject matter expert in developing one of the first formal construction trade training curriculum and achievement records for Job Corps. As a placement coordinator, he placed over 1,000 Job Corps graduates in career-progressive employment or apprenticeship programs in the home building industry.

Tirone is committed to make a difference with today's youth by providing training and career opportunities for disenfranchised and disadvantaged youth and continues to seek new ways to promote the residential construction industry as a career of choice for young people.
