Keith Albright serves as the Vice President for the Home Builders Institute (HBI) and has more than 30 years of experience educating and training adults and youth for journeyman, pre-apprenticeship and apprenticeship positions in the building industry.

In his current role, Mr. Albright oversees the operation of HBI's largest residential construction training program. Since joining HBI in 1981, Albright has served in an array of positions including Career Technical Instructor, National Placement Coordinator, Director and Vice President for HBI Job Corps.

As a senior executive, Albright acts as a liaison between HBI and the National Office of Job Corps, housed in the United States Department of Labor's Employment and Training Administration. He works directly with industry leaders and government agencies developing training and employment opportunities for at-risk youth. Albright directs the recruitment, selection, hiring, training, and orientation of all HBI Job Corps managerial and support staff and oversees the development of all training curricula.

From the onset of his career in the building industry Albright has been involved in construction trades education and training. He served on apprenticeship committees, chaired the SkillsUSA National Carpentry Championships for 15 years, and was instrumental in establishing scholarship funds for Job Corps students.

Albright has served on numerous National Office of Job Corps committees developing policy, standard operating procedures, and curricula. He currently serves as Co-Chair for the National Training Contractors of Job Corps, a group of eight construction trade organizations dedicated to providing Job Corps youth the most advanced technical trades training possible.
