HBI C-CORE participants are matched with an adult mentor who offers support, good advice, direction, and a positive example. Over time, your mentor will help you develop the leadership and work skills that will help you get a job and build a career.

BENEFITS FOR YOU

No matter where you are in life, and what you've been through, you can use a little help with the challenges in building a future, a career and your potential. Your HBI C-CORE mentor will be a dependable role model who provides support, constructive criticism and a sympathetic ear to your concerns. Since they work in the industry, they can help you learn important skills and find potential job opportunities.

You and several other students will be matched with an adult mentor who will share their experiences and support. Each week you will spend an average of two hours with your mentor. The types of activities you will do together include:

- Taking part in local construction-related community service projects;
- Attending local home builders association meetings or industry events;
- Being introduced to other members of the local building community;
- Visiting your mentor's job site; and
- Spending time talking and receiving advice.



WHO'S ELIGIBLE?

To participate in the HBI C-CORE program you must be between the ages of 16 and 18 years old, live in one of the program's participating states, and need the help of a mentor in your life.

Why do I need a coach?

Reaching your goals won't always be easy, but a mentor, like a good coach, can help make the path easier to find and follow.

What's in it for me?

The time commitment isn't overwhelming. You'll be asked to spend around 2 hours per week with your mentor and other members of the team.

What will be expected of me?

You will be required to maintain good attendance in the program and work with your mentor to identify specific goals as part of your personal development plan.
